Sam, a former classroom educator, knows how schools work and how to engage with students and facilitate safe and respectful conversations. As the need for **Social Emotional Learning** (SEL) becomes more evident, Sam has structured his school programming options to stay consistent with the themes and objectives of SEL.

Sam Drazin was born with Treacher Collins Syndrome, a rare congenital disorder resulting in facial anomaly and hearing loss. Sam's experiences as a student with a difference and later as a teacher

working in an inclusive elementary school classroom helped him recognize the importance of providing students with opportunities to engage in meaningful conversations about what it means to be different. Sam has visited more than 150 schools across the country, presenting to more than 30,000 students in grades K-12.





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
